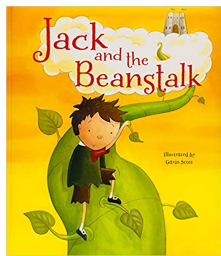

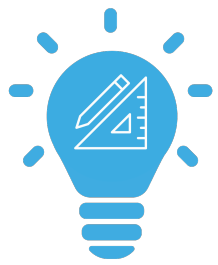

MATH

Learning Outcome: The children through the following activities will develop and strengthen their mathematical thinking, communication and social skills.

Monday

Interview every family member to create a "Who is Your Favorite Character in the story?" graph.

Materials: paper, pens, markers, family members

Instructions:

Step 1: Have paper ready to create your graph.

Step 2: Write down your findings

Step 3: Have fun and enjoy this time with your child.

Tuesday

Giant's hand estimation (use beans to count)

Materials: paper, pencils, markers, lima beans, scissors, glue

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Draw an adult's handprint and pretend is the Giant's handprint.

Step 3: Glue or place lima beans inside the handprint.

Step 4: Count how many lima beans take to fill the giant's handprint.

Step 5: How many lima beans did it take to fill up the giant's handprint.

Step 6: Have fun with your child.

Wednesday

Giant's foot estimation (use beans to count)

Materials: paper, pencils, markers, lima beans, scissors, glue

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Draw an adult's footprint and pretend is the Giant's footprint.

Step 3: Glue or place lima beans inside the footprint.

Step 4: Count how many lima beans take to fill the giant's footprint.

Step 5: How many lima beans did it take to fill up the giant's footprint.

Step 6: Have fun with your child.

Thursday

Practice patterns: bean, leaf, cow, castle, etc.

Materials: pattern picture card Bean, Leaf, Cow, Castle etc.

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Start patterning your Jack and beanstalk characters.

Step 3: Ask questions: "What is the same and what is different?"

Step 4: Create a pattern

Step 5: Have fun with your child.

Friday

Count gold coins. How high can you count? If you do not have coins, draw them.

Materials: paper, pens, crayons, markers, gold coins

Instructions:

Step 1: Have materials ready.

Step 2: If you do not have gold coins, draw them.

Step 3: Start counting coins!

Step 4: How high can you count?

Step 5: Have fun with your child



ART

Learning Outcome: The children will have the opportunity to develop and strengthen their creativity with this week's activity.

Monday

Create a beanstalk

Materials: green construction paper, green streamers, tape, glue, string, creativity

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Encourage your child to get messy and start designing their beanstalk.

Step 3: Use your creativity.

Step 4: Will it be tall? Will it be short?

Step 5: Use glue, tape or any other materials to create a beanstalk.

Step 4: Have fun and enjoy this time with your child.

Tuesday

Create the giant's feet

Materials: paper, crayons, markers, pencils, Sharpie marker, scissors

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Start tracing the giant's feet. What do you think you will need? How big do you think it will be?

Step 3: Paint or color your giant's foot. Use your creativity.

Step 4: Have fun with your child

Wednesday

Create clouds

Materials: glue, construction paper, Sharpie marker, scissors

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Start creating a set of clouds.

Step 3: Glue cotton balls inside the clouds.

Step 4: Are clouds soft? Are they hard?

Step 5: Where do you find the clouds? On the bottom or above the castle?

Step 5: Have fun with your child

Thursday

Create a castle

Materials: paper, crayons, glitter, paint, empty toilet paper and paper towel rolls

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Use your Imagination! Encourage your child to create their own castle. They can use paper, paint, empty paper towel rolls to create.

Step 3: Have fun with your child.

Friday

Paint a boiled egg yellow or gold

Materials: boiled egg in hot water, plastic egg, yellow or gold paint, gold or silver glitter

Instructions:

Step 1: Have materials ready.

Step 2: First boil egg in hot water or use a plastic egg.

Step 3: Paint the boiled or plastic egg.

Step 4: Have fun with your child.



SENSORY

Learning Outcome: The children will have the opportunity to develop and strengthen their creativity with this week's activity.

Monday

Jack and the Beanstalk sensory bin.

Materials: castle print out, lima beans, bin, green pipe cleaners, green construction paper, empty paper towel roll, green paint, paint brush,

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Encourage your child to get messy.

Step 3: Pour lima beans inside bin.

Step 4: Create the story with the castle and the beanstalk.

Step 5: Write letter on the lima beans.

Step 6: Have children find the letters of their name.

Step 7: Have fun and enjoy this time with your child.

Tuesday

Wash your castle that you build with soap and water.

Materials: Legos, blocks, dish soap, water, bin, empty toilet paper and paper towels rolls, tape.

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Encourage your child to get messy.

Step 3: Encourage your child to build a castle with blocks, Legos or use empty paper towels rolls.

Step 4: Pour water inside the bin and mix with dish soap.

Step 5: Have fun with your child.

Step 6: Have fun with your child.

Wednesday

Build a castle in the clouds.

Materials: Legos, blocks, shaving cream, bin, empty toilet paper towel and toilet paper rolls, tape.

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Encourage your child to get messy.

Step 3: Encourage your child to build a castle with blocks, Legos or use empty paper towels rolls.

Step 4: Spray shaving cream Inside empty bin.

Step 5: Cover castle with shaving cream to create clouds.

Step 6: Have fun with your child.

Thursday

Ice Castle

Materials: glitter, stickers, ice cube trays, water, large bowl, vinegar, droppers.

Instructions:

Step 1: Have all materials ready.

Step 2: Encourage your child to get messy.

Step 3: Fill ice cube trays or a large bowl with water.

Step 4: Mix glitter, stickers inside the ice cube trays or in the large bowls to create the Illusion of a castle.

Step 5: Pour vinegar Inside a cup and use droppers to melt the ice cube castle.

Step 6: Have fun with your child.

Friday

Wash your gold or yellow egg

Materials: plastic or boiled egg, water, brushes, bin, dish soap.

Instructions:

Step 1: Have materials ready.

Step 2: Encourage your child to get messy.

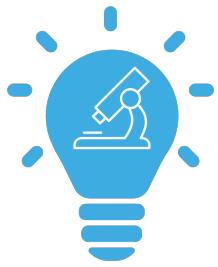
Step 3: Pour water Inside the bin.

Step 4: Mix dish soap and water.

Step 5: Place egg Inside the bin.

Step 6: Use your brush to wash and scrub your golden or yellow egg.

Step 7: Have fun with your child.



STEM & MAKERSPACE

Learning Outcome: The children will have the opportunity to use their creativity and enhance their scientific thinking and communication skills. Children will learn to predict, observe, record, analyze the data.

Step 9: Have fun and enjoy this time with your child.	<i>Instructions:</i> Step 1: Have all materials ready. Step 2: Encourage children to use their Imagination and start creating a beanstalk. Step 3: Children will need to use tape, straws, any recyclables to create beanstalk. Step 4: Have fun with your child	<i>Instructions:</i> Step 1: Have all materials ready. Step 2: Start building a castle. Step 3: Use all materials and use your creativity. Step 4: Make sure castle is steady and strong. 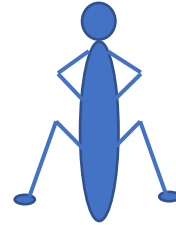
